The refrigerator will be located outside of the campus's cafeteria.

This way students can easily access the food at any time, it reduces food waste but it also brings more profit to vendors, because normally they would just throw the food away. That way we contribute to a greener, more sustainable campus life.

Of course, we know that similar apps already exist, but what makes our app unique is the 24/7 availability of the food. By using a big refrigerator, we automate the process by allowing the students to go and get the food at any time they can, reducing the stress of arriving on time at the campus restaurant.
