## How does it work?

On 1 November you will receive information on how to use moodle as well as login details for using Zoom.

Working in teams: Once you've found participants to form a team and together you are working on a specific project, as a team you decide on how you want to proceed. As team you will perform general coordination and consultation work using moodle, such as for main communication or documentation purposes. All other tools to work collaboratively can be chosen by the teams themselves. To that end, you can orient yourself on the moodle tools or use tried-and-tested tools from your university or organisation.

Support: Every challenge will be supervised by an **idea facilitator** who will bring you together with other participants to form a team and help you to better understand the problem. If your challenge does not have an

idea facilitator, please familiarize yourself with the challenge and build up a common understanding with the other participants interested in that challenge. **Mentors** are also available to support the teams with their professional expertise.
