What is DigiEduHack?

- Flagship initiative of the EC that aims to foster grassroots innovation, collaboration and creativity and to drive positive change in **digital** education.
- **24-hours local hackathons** taking place worldwide over a period of 8 days. Open to **anyone** regardless of technical skill level! *We are looking for ideas as well as technical solutions as a result of these hackathons.*
- Annual theme 2023: Putting people at the centre of digital education
- First implemented under the Digital Education Action Plan 2018-2020, and continues under the Digital Education Action Plan 2021-2027.
- The initiative has strong synergies with the <u>European Digital Education</u> <u>Hub</u>.


